
Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grants – DOE's Largest Local Program

- \$3.2 billion to over 2,300 local communities
- Energy efficiency/sustainability
- Jobs
- EECEBG funds
 - \$2.7 billion of formula grants
 - \$454 million competitive Retrofit Ramp-up Program
